



CANADA DRIVER RECORDS

Also called a Driver Abstract, this government-issued document provides verified information about a driver's current and previous record over the past three years, including:

- Licence status (suspensions and reinstatements)
- Defaulted fines
- Highway Traffic Act convictions, and dates
- Canada Criminal Code convictions, and dates
- Accumulated demerit points

A Driver Record can be an important addition to your screening tool-kit as it contains information not found in other background reports.

Driver Records are increasingly required by vehicle insurers and by employers to evaluate job applicants. They can also be useful to housing providers in assessing a potential applicant's reliability and compliance.
